


# Operation of the Challenge

- Participants begin the simulation with \$200,000 CAD on February 14, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.
- They may engage in trading and portfolio management activities until April 14, 2022, at 4:00 p.m.
- Award ceremony in May 2022







### 3 components

- Financial performance
  - Financial return realized during the simulation
- Portfolio management
  - 14 automated management evaluation measures; jury evaluation
- Responsible investing
  - Qualification questionnaire and application form; jury evaluation







### 3 groups of participants

- High school students
  - 1764 participants in 2021
- College students
  - 838 participants in 2021
- General public and university students

## 2 types of portfolio

- "Bourstad" portfolio 595 Securities
  - 260 shares of Canadian companies
  - 128 shares of U.S. companies
  - 86 shares of companies from outside North America
  - 101 exchange-traded funds
  - 36 actively managed funds
  - 6 currencies








## 2 types of portfolio

- "Bourstad Plus" portfolio
  - 100 additional securities
    - 72 options traded on the Montreal Exchange.
    - 28 leveraged index mutual funds traded in the U.S.



- Implementation of a no-cumulation rule for all special awards
  - No longer possible to combine a special award with the corresponding prize for the entire participation category (high school, college or general public)
- the criteria for the Responsible Investment Awards will now take into account the participant's detailed participation report in addition to the results of the qualification test













